Shireland Basketball continues to hit new heights






Year 12 Elephant Group Visit UCL for Personal Statement Workshop








Field Studies Council Trip





Y12 Biology Field Trip

In May, our Year 12 biologists headed out of the classroom and into the wild with the Field Studies Council, immersing themselves in biodiversity fieldwork techniques. The day kicked off with a safety briefing, then we tackled habitat comparisons—sampling species, calculating diversity, and analysing data using real statistical tests. It was fantastic seeing students trying methods like interrupted belt transects and quadrat sampling firsthand. One standout moment was when a dedicated student spent most of the day swatting flies away with their clipboard—nature's own resistance training! Watching the students push beyond their comfort zones, enthusiastically identifying organisms in woodland and meadow habitats, was a real joy to behold. The teamwork, curiosity and laughter (and the occasional fly-swatter!) made it an unforgettable day. Here's to more adventures in science—where learning meets laughter and the natural world becomes our classroom.
