### **Academy Uniform Reminder**

Following a recent uniform inspection, we are very pleased to report that the vast majority of our students looked impeccable and adhered to the Academy's uniform policy. We would like to thank you for your continued support in maintaining our high standards.

However, there are a few areas of concern that we would like to bring to your attention so that they can be addressed over the half-term break. These include:

- False eyelashes
- Black trainers (instead of appropriate school shoes)
- Gym-style stretch flared trousers

We would like to reiterate that false eyelashes and heavy make-up are not permitted. All students must wear suitable plain black leather school shoes or boots (trainers are not allowed). Trousers must be school trousers and not jersey or leisurewear styles.

Students are expected to attend the Academy in full uniform every day. Our uniform policy is regularly reinforced by Heads of Year and Form Tutors throughout the academic year.
