Early Closure
Wednesday, 24 June 2026

Following a review of the weather forecast and conditions within the academy, we have taken the decision to implement an **early closure at 12.30pm on Wednesday 24 June**.

We have worked hard to maintain normal operations and ensure that learning continues for as much of the day as possible. However, forecasts indicate that temperatures will continue to rise throughout the afternoon and, after carefully considering the wellbeing of our students and staff, we believe that an early finish is the most appropriate course of action.

Students will follow their normal timetable during the morning. We ask that parents and carers make arrangements for their child to be collected or to travel home safely from 12.30pm. Students eligible for free school meals will be able to collect a grab bag from the canteen as they are dismissed.

The decision has not been taken lightly. Whilst we recognise the importance of maintaining learning, we must also consider the increasing temperatures expected during the afternoon, the comfort and welfare of students and staff, and the challenges that prolonged periods of heat can present within school buildings.

We will be continuing our temporary relaxed approach to uniform whilst students are in the Academy during the morning of Wednesday, 24 June. Students will not be expected to wear blazers or ties during this time. In addition, students may attend school in their PE kit if they feel more comfortable doing so in the warmer conditions.

We would also encourage all families to take sensible precautions during the hot weather, including:

- Drinking plenty of water throughout the day.
- Avoiding prolonged periods in direct sunlight during the hottest part of the afternoon.
- Wearing appropriate clothing and sun protection when outdoors.
- Looking out for signs of heat exhaustion and seeking advice if concerns arise.

At present, we are continuing to monitor the forecast for Thursday and will communicate any further updates as soon as possible.
